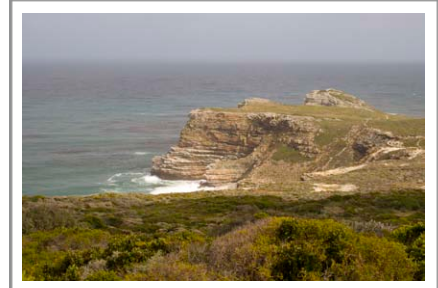


SAA - APTA 2010 ANNUAL INDABA EDUCATIONAL TRIP REPORT
